HANDS TO BUILD : HEARTS TO FILL

"This is what the Lord Almighty says: "Give careful thought to your ways. Go up into the mountains and bring down timber and build my house, so that I may take pleasure in it and be honoured," says the Lord. "You expected much, but see, it turned out to be little. What you brought home, I blew away. Why?" declares the Lord Almighty. "Because of my house, which remains a ruin, while each of you is busy with your own house." – Haggai 1:7–9 NIV

1/ Hearts to Fill:

God is calling us into greater trust in Him. There is a kingdom priority; an order of things. We dishonour God and break trust when we tend to ourselves first. We honour God and build relationship when we build His house first.

Worry causes us to seek our own security. Trust in God allows us to seek His purposes and plans because we know that we are taken care of. Ultimately, glory flows to the open vessel of obedience, and obedience is an act of trust in a loving God.

When the Israelites rebuilt the temple, it was worse physically than the last one. And yet God promised to fill the temple with his glory, greater than the glory of the former house.

Romans 8:18–19 reads: "I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us. For the creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed."

We are believing for greater glory: more transformed lives, more of God's glory revealed in us. and in those who are to come!

2/ Hands to Build:

- a. Our priority is our prayer life; our conversations with Jesus. How can I structure my day/week/month around conversations with Jesus?
- **b.** We believe in putting action to our prayers. Putting down and picking up activities in our lives. What do I need to do to build God's house/the local church/ this group of believers? Uniting with the same heart but different roles.
- **c.** We want to focus on raising leadership in our children. We believe that God wants to reveal His glory in the next generation of the Church. To do this we have budgeted staffing time for Children's Pastors: James and Ruby Hodgson.

We must be on the front foot of Kingdom movement in the Spirit and in the natural. We must forge forward in the Spirit of Jesus, with a loud and clear voice to our region, our nation, and our world. There is hope in Christ. There is glory in the house; the people of God, shining with a supernatural and mysterious light. No one can look away, no one can ignore what God looks like shining out of us. They will know of God when they see us. They will notice the glory!
